<p>Shall the Town amend its acceptance of sections 3 to 7, inclusive, of chapter 44B of the General Laws, as approved by its legislative body, a summary of which appears below?</p> <p style="text-align: center; font-weight: bold;">SUMMARY:</p> <p style="text-align: center; font-size: small;">In 2007, the Town accepted the Community Preservation Act, which established a dedicated funding source for: open space, including land for recreational use; historic resources; and community housing. The Town of Essex originally approved a surcharge of 0.5% on the annual tax levy on real property. Increasing the surcharge to 1.5%, as approved by the November 16, 2015 Town Meeting, would make additional funding available for community preservation purposes, and would make the Town eligible for a higher level of matching funds from the State. If this question is approved, the increase in the surcharge would take effect in Fiscal Year 2017.</p>
