<b>Glass</b>	Glass bottles/jars – Clear, green, and brown Rinse clean and remove lids, collars Neck Rings and corks. Paper labels may Stay on.	No broken glass or other glass items such as window glass, dishes, glasses, pyrex, ceramics, light bulbs
<b>Metal</b>	Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids Non-deposit beverage cans Deposit beverage cans (Boy Scout Trailer) Rinse clean, may flatten, labels may stay on	No cans containing aerosol or hazardous material.
<b>Paper</b>	Newspaper/inserts (including glossy newsprint) Magazines, Junk mail, catalogs, phonebooks	No soiled paper, pizza boxes, or plastic bags, no waxed paper, or Cardboard
<b>Plastic</b>	Plastic containers #1-#7 can now be recycled Empty and rinse clean Remove lids and neck rings	no plastic bags
<b>Cardboard</b>	Corrugated cardboard – please flatten	
<b>Misc. items</b>	\$10.00 fee for TV's, and Monitors \$10.00 fee for large appliances (Stoves, oven, dishwashers, hot water tanks, furnaces etc) \$15.00 fee for any item with Freon (Freezers, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, AC's, water coolers etc)

<b>Mercury</b>	There is a shed located at the transfer Station for items that contain mercury such as fluorescent light bulbs, mercury switches, thermostats, thermometers, button cell batteries, blood pressure units, etc
